July 25, 2009 4-6 Babysitters are needed from 8:30-11:20a

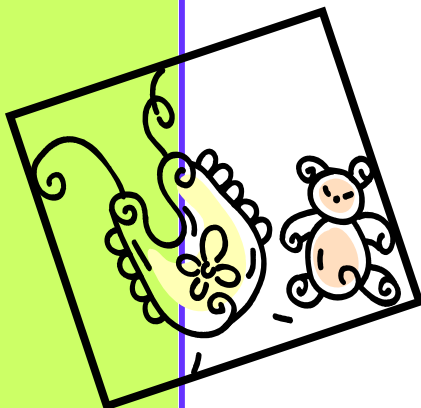
